

SO YOU'VE GOT THE DIAGNOSIS, NOW WHAT?

What is NDIS and how does it work?

The National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) provides funding for eligible people with disability. People that are eligible become **NDIS participants**. They are able to access funding for necessary and reasonable supports that will help them to live their lives with family, friends and the wider community, access therapeutic services and helps them to achieve their goals.





TO REGISTER:

- disability caused by impairment
- probably permanent impairment
- impairment impacts on ability to do one or more daily life activities
- impairment greatly affects ability to work, study or engage socially



STEP BY STEP HOW TO

1. Get the Access Request Form

Go to the NDIS website, download the **Access Request Form** and print this out





2. Complete the 1st section of the Form

Fill in the first section of the form with all the details related to the person with the disability

3. Get Doctor to complete Form

Take the Access Request Form to the medical practitioner to complete the 2nd section





4. Send to NDIS

Email the completed form to nat@ndis.gov.au
